


# **5.25 Retro Ceiling Speaker**

Thank you for selecting this Posh high-performance speaker. Posh has gained an enviable track record providing professionals with audiophile-quality speakers for commercial installations.

### **Product feature identification**



## **TOOLS NEEDED**

These instructions are for installing the Posh 5.25 Retro Ceiling Speaker into conventional gypsum drywall "wallboard" or drop-tile ceilings. The process is extremely easy and requires a minimum of tools.

**PENCIL** for marking around template

**HOLE SAW** for cutting speaker holes

WIRE STRIPPER for preparing speaker wires

PHILLIPS-TYPE SCREWDRIVER

"STUD FINDER" (optional)

#### **Fast-track "express" instructions**

We urge you to read this Installation Guide carefully. However, if you're an experienced commercial installer or just impatient, here's the short version:

- Select the speaker location, checking for the position of ceiling joists and the location of electrical and plumbing conduits.
- 2. Mark cut-out hole outlines with the included cardboard template.
- 3. Cut hole in the ceiling.
- 4. Run speaker wire and connect to input terminals.
- 5. If required, wire safety loop to building structure.
- Install speaker assembly into cut-out hole and secure by tightening dogleg screws. BE SURE NOT TO TIGHTEN TOO FAST OR TOO TIGHT!
- 7. Press on the speaker grille cover.

### Step 1

Use the supplied template to scribe and then cut the hole for the speaker. Pull the wire through the cutout hole.


### Step 2

#### A. Sheetrock ceiling

Insert the C-ring through the hole so that the two tabs face away from the hole, and the flange on the C-ring points down through the hole in the sheetrock.

#### **B.** Drop-tile ceiling

After Step A, attach the two support rails to the C-ring, and adjust so that the rails abut the T-channel grid. Use sheetmetal screws to secure the support rails to the C-ring.




NOTE: If the rough-in bracket is used, it is not necessary to use the C-ring or support rails as shown in Step 2. Instead, in Step 5 below, use the doglegs to attach the speaker to the rough-in bracket instead of the C-ring.


### Step 3

Using a Phillips screwdriver, loosen the screw holding the terminal cover, and slide open. Strip 3/8" off the end of the wire insulation. Slide the wire through the strain relief fitting. Attach the speaker wire to the spring-loaded clips located at the top of the speaker can. Make sure positive (red) and negative (black) are correct. When daisy-chaining, insert two wires into positive and two wires into negative. Tighten down the strain-relief fitting using the two small screws. Slide the terminal cover closed, and tighten the screw.

The safety loop is for securing the loudspeaker to the building structure with wire cabling. This will provide a secondary support where required by code or in seismic areas.




### Step 4



Using a coin or screwdriver, adjust the wattage tap selector switch to desired setting. The selector switch is located to the side of the terminal cover.

### Step 5




(a) Insert and center the speaker into the ceiling opening. Make sure all four doglegs rest on the C-ring. (b) Tighten down the four doglegs by turning the screws, located on the driver side of the baffle, clockwise.

BE SURE NOT TO TIGHTEN TOO FAST OR TOO TIGHT!

## Step 6



Insert the metal grille. The grille will friction-mount into place, and is additionally secured with a rubberized compound. Make sure the grille is flush with the speaker bezel.
